



I don't think I rocked how I looked — Justin, 19

If you stop caring about things, if you feel you've been let down, or even let yourself down, it's easy to stop looking after yourself. My mam wasn't around anymore to check me and give me the once over in the morning. She died last year and things had been hard.

I found myself wearing the same clothes day after day. I stopped shaving. Stopped having my daily shower. And nobody will say anything to you, not even your mates. After a while, I wasn't really looking the part I needed to be. So when you go for job interviews, you've got no chance.

They're polite. They'll say, "We don't think you're quite what we're looking for" and stuff like that, but the real problem is that other people don't really want to be around you or have you on the team. You know like when you are at school and you are the last one picked for sports.

I was that guy. I say "was" because I'm not now. I went on a Fast Track to Work programme and they really helped me.

We did the usual stuff, not that it was boring or anything - understanding benefits, budgeting and how to survive until you get a job, CVs, applications and writing good letters — all that was great.

But it was the personal presentation stuff that really worked for me. It was the fact that someone cared and helped me to feel important again, they were there to check me like mam, until I got my head into gear and did it myself.

They were very sensitive. They didn't embarrass me or anything. But they talked to me about how I could present myself better. They talked about clothes, hygiene, how I spoke.

They gave me tons of confidence. Really. They sorted me right out. They were right beside me when I landed a traineeship that became an apprenticeship that became a job.

So I'm working and earning. I can hardly believe it.



l became a label – Jayden, 17

When I was at school, everybody knew me. I was really popular. It felt good. I didn't enjoy lessons and all that but I loved hanging out with my friends and having a good time.

I got pregnant really young but Sarah is my special girl. She's really great. She's my everything. But I became a label — a young unemployed mum. People didn't see me as Jayden, someone who loves life, but as someone who's on benefits with a kid. They didn't see a loving young mother. It's as

if being on benefits made everything else about me invisible. I've got a brain. I know that if I worked hard I could really make something of my life. And I want to now. I want Sarah

to have all the chances she can. She's two now. But she's really clever. Speaks well. She's switched on, she really is.

I didn't think it would be this hard to get people to see me differently. It was a real struggle at first. But I was determined. So I went along to Family Learning. The one thing I noticed was not being judged. They saw me again.

I hadn't realised how much of my confidence I'd lost. But I'm back.

ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

Many people discover, sometimes years after leaving school, that they develop an interest in going to university.

Increasingly, it can be hard to advance at work if you're not a graduate, although not impossible. But getting back into full time study can be challenging. It's very easy to get out of the studying habit.

An Access to Higher Education course can be the best way to re-familiarise yourself with the academic way of thinking. More, it can help universities judge whether you've got what it takes to succeed at degree level.

Being a graduate can open doors for you. It can give you a chance to explore a new career, help you to develop your interests and increase your earning power. Graduates tend to have higher career earnings than those who do not have a degree.

Access to HE courses are open to anyone over 18. Our courses run in both Hexham and Alnwick. If you are successful, you will have a recognised qualification that will get you into the university of your choice. You'll study over one or two years, depending on how the study fits around your lifestyle.

I never thought I'd go to university. When I was at school, my mates were all obsessed with talking about where they were going to study but I never felt part of that. It didn't worry me that they were going off and I was staying at home. I wanted to be earning. I wanted a car, maybe a house.

I was lucky to get a job soon after I left school. I didn't have great A levels — a couple of Ds. But I wasn't surrounded by graduates at work so it wasn't a problem. I found that if you're prepared to work, to put the hours in and to be enthusiastic, then you can get on. And that's what I thought I'd be doing — working, earning, spending, living.

But I started to get a nagging feeling. I was happy enough but every now and then I'd wonder whether I could have achieved more. My girlfriend may have triggered my unease when she asked me if I'd ever regretted anything. I said no but when I started to think about I think I did.

I started to look at university websites. I even talked to some of my mates who'd by now graduated. I realised I was going to have to do something about it. I realised that I didn't want to look back and think I'd somehow missed out.

My lifesaver was an Access to Higher Education course. Getting back to serious study can be challenging. But the course got me ready for that. There were lots of study tips. We met admission tutors. We topped up our IT and writing skills. By the time I finished the course, I was ready to go and hungry.

I'm in my second year now. I'm really into my course and because I got my student loan, I don't have to pay it back until I'm earning good money. If you're keen to take a degree, my advice is: take an access course.

It's the best way to get back into full time study. Bar none.



BE IN WORK AND EARNING

Or you may have left and have no prospects.

Say you want to get a job but you don't have the right qualifications — or experience — what could you do? You might still be at school and keen to leave but feel you can't.

Two words might help you: **traineeships** and **apprenticeships**. Both could offer you a future.

You might not realise it, but even if you're at school you could still choose another route, and apply for either a traineeship or an apprenticeship. The key is to be still learning.

TRAINFFSHIPS

A traineeship is a placement with a business, organisation or company to get you ready for work or further development. You have to be between 16 and 24 years old.

This might be a good option for you if you have applied for apprenticeships or work and haven't been offered a place. It could be that people have felt that you're not quite ready for work. It could even be that you're not really sure yet what you want to do.

A traineeship gives you the opportunity to get ready for work.

You would:

- Do off the job classes in English, Maths, ICT and employability
- · Receive a personal coach and mentor
- Attend work experience with a great local employer
- Be able to try more than one occupation at a time
- · Have the chance to show an employer what you are made of
- Be able to fast track to an apprenticeship, you'll be apprenticeship ready by the end of the programme


Traineeships last from between one and sixth months — and they don't affect your benefits. You would not normally be paid but you may be eligible for financial help, and help with your child care and travel.

The key thing about traineeships is that they prepare you for work or apprenticeships. They help you to build confidence and to understand the skills and behaviours that employers are looking for.

All vacancies are advertised online. All applicants will get a one to one guidance interview to help find the perfect traineeship and prepare you for an employer interview.

APPRENTICESHIPS

Apprenticeships are on the job training opportunities.

They are often the best way into work since they give you the chance to work with an employer, to understand their business and to develop your skills at the same time. They're perfect for people who learn by doing rather than by studying.

They give employers the chance to see where your future lies when your apprenticeship is completed. What's more, you earn while you learn. Apprentices can earn upwards of £100 a week.

You would:

- Be invited to a screening and interview day to help prepare you for interviews
- Do off the job classes in English, Maths, ICT, rights and responsibilities, thinking and learning skills
- Receive a personal lecturer who will guide you through the programme
- Be trained for an occupation and get your 'ticket' to practice

The thing is that there are so many people like her — older people have so much to talk about. I love what I do.

I can't imagine doing anything else.





I have been interested in photography for years but never really done much about it.


My first camera was a Kodak brownie. Can you remember them?

What can I learn and at which level?

All our course descriptions are available at

www.northumberland.gov.uk/adultlearning. Here you will find information on who the course is aimed at, the content, the teaching and assessment, and pathways that show you how to progress on completion. Entry level and level 1 courses are targeted at beginners, level 2 at intermediate learners, and level 3 and 4 courses are for advanced learners. We have different types of courses:

Further Education Skills Courses

These courses are designed to help you build your professional and technical skills or get a second chance at education if you haven't succeeded in learning before. Courses help you to return to work, or prepare you to go on to higher level studies. All of our skills courses involve assessment for a nationally recognised qualification like awards, certificates, diplomas, GCSE's, A Levels and Access to Higher Education Diplomas.

Community Learning

These courses are designed to help you learn for leisure and pleasure, build your skills in hobbies or interests, or it may be your first experience of

learning in a long time and you want to get back into the swing of studying. It is a great place to start if you want to progress on to a skills course.

Leisure Courses, Clubs and Groups

These courses are informal classes, clubs and groups. Some groups are self-programming where there is no leader and group members teach and support each other. Other clubs and groups are just like traditionally taught courses and will have a tutor. They attract no subsidy so we cannot offer free fees for these activities. We'll let you know when you enrol if this is the case.

How do I enrol?

Most of our courses are open enrolment. For some of our courses at higher levels you will need to apply for the course and we may need to talk to you about your suitability for the course. If this is the case we will let you know when you contact us to enrol.

You can enrol by telephone or in person at one of our centres.

Enrolments can be taken at our centres from Tuesday 1st September 2015. Most centres are open Monday to Thursday 9am to 7.30pm. Full opening times are published on the website.



How do I pay?

You can:

- Pay for your course by debit or credit card, cash or cheque. You need to pay your fees in full before classes start.
- Apply for an instalment arrangement where fees exceed £150.00: ask about our terms and conditions at any centre.
- Apply for an Advanced Learning Loan if you are 24+ and studying at level 3 or higher. The full conditions for applying for and repaying a loan can be found at https://www.gov.uk/advanced-learning-loans
- Apply for fee remission. On skills courses and community learning we offer free study if you are in one of the groups listed below. You must provide proof of entitlement before you start or the offer of your place will be withdrawn. The following learners are entitled to free study during 2015/2016:
 - 16-18 years at the start of the course
 - 19-24 years and undertaking a Traineeship
 - 19+ and studying English or Maths learning aims
 - 19+ and studying GCSE English or Maths, where you do not currently have these qualifications at grades A* to C
 - 19-23 years studying entry or level 1 and have not yet achieved above level 1, and progressing to first full level 2
 - 19-23 years studying level 2 and have not yet achieved above level 1, and progressing to first full level 2
 - 19-23 years and studying first full level 2 qualification
 - 19-23 years and studying first full level 3 qualification
 - 19-23 years and studying first level 4 or above without having achieved a first full level 3 qualification
 - 19-23 years studying up to level 4 who need help to move into work, progress in work or remove a barrier to getting into work, and who are
 - receiving JSA, ESA and are in the work-related activity group or receiving Universal Credit and mandated to training
 - unemployed, receiving any state benefit, want to enter employment and where the course is directly relevant to your employment prospects

- 24+ years studying up to level 2 who need help to move into work, progress in work or remove a barrier to getting into work, and who are:
 - receiving JSA, ESA and are in the work-related activity group or receiving Universal Credit and mandated to training
 - unemployed, receiving any state benefit, want to enter employment and where the course is directly relevant to your employment prospects
 - 24+ years old and am studying my first full level 2 or first full level 3 qualification and left the British armed forces within the last 10 years after completing four or more years of service or have been medically discharged, after completing basic training
