

I was mandated to this course! Eddie, 48

I was told by the Job Centre that I had to attend a two-week programme for Employability. I wasn't thrilled about this. I attended the pre-course interview where I found out what was going to be covered and met the other people on the course.

The course started the following week on a Monday morning at 9.30 am (urgh). The tutor was great and made me feel at ease straight away. The people on the course were really friendly; we were all in the same boat.

We started looking at different types of jobs and had to improve our CVs. I had thought mine was pretty good until we started this. We looked at all sorts of things including budgeting and this made me wonder why I'd never budgeted before!

Part of this course was doing some IT. I felt I was good using email but I found out all sorts of new things with the internet and Word. I also found out I could budget on a spreadsheet which was completely new to me. It showed me why I was always short of cash and how to get in control of my money whilst I was looking for a job. We did some job searches online and found out how to attach our CVs. I was chuffed to bits.

The two weeks just flew by and at the end of it we had to do interviews. I was really nervous about this even though we had practised it before. It went really well and the tutor said I did great. I've got a couple of interviews for jobs and hopefully all of this practice will help me. I'm keeping my fingers crossed that I get one of them!

I feel confident and ready for the next steps into employment.



Success on a plate – Judy, 27

I'm dyslexic and I really struggled with school work. Although I had help, I just couldn't keep up and my exam results were pretty rubbish. I found a job as a cleaner in a local factory but I can't really say I loved my work. When things got tough for the factory, I was made redundant.

I decided to stop and take stock of what I wanted to do next but I didn't have much time to think about it or to wait for courses to start. I needed money coming in soon.

I love cooking and I love eating, so I thought that maybe something to do with food might be the way forward. I managed to get on a basic professional cookery course starting just a week after I was made redundant. I got on food hygiene too. Just having a bit more knowledge helped me blag a bit of work experience at a local eatery. I found it fun but hot in the kitchen but really took to front of house work. I loved setting the place up for the day, taking bookings and especially meeting lots of people. I even didn't mind it when the chef got wound up and yelled at everyone!

The more I worked, the better I got. I was dead chuffed. Even more when I was offered a proper contract. It was only part time but I was getting paid and could do some further training on my days off.

I signed up for a Level 2 Hospitality course and again I started nearly straight away. Couldn't believe how easy it was. No waiting around for months. I even had another go at improving my maths and English. That must have impressed my bosses as they decided to take me on full time. They even let me continue on my course and I'm not far off completing.

All the tutors I've worked with have been so helpful and they've always given me that extra support for my dyslexia. Now I'm in a job I really love, meeting lots of people and keeping everything running smoothly.

SO YOU WANT TO TAKE A DEGREE... ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

Many people discover, sometimes years after leaving school, that they develop an interest in going to university.

Increasingly, it can be hard to advance at work if you're not a graduate, although not impossible. But getting back into full time study can be challenging. It's very easy to get out of the studying habit.

An Access to Higher Education course can be the best way to re-familiarise yourself with the academic way of thinking. More, it can help universities judge whether you've got what it takes to succeed at degree level.

Being a graduate can open doors for you. It can give you a chance to explore a new career, help you to develop your interests and increase your earning power. Graduates tend to have higher career earnings than those who do not have a degree.

The diploma is a full level 3 qualification, recognised and accepted by most Higher Education Institutions as one of the main routes into university for adult learners who do not have the traditional school qualifications. It is the equivalent of 3 A Levels.

The diploma is for people aged over 19 who want to go to university but:

- didn't get the A Levels they needed or have old qualifications and may need a refresher
- have not been in education for some time or
- want a change in direction or pursue a new career

The course can be done over one or two years.

The course is funded by you taking an Advanced Learning Loan. The great news is that if you then go on to complete a degree, your Advanced Learning Loan is written off.

We are offering Access to Higher Education routes to:

- Allied Health Professions and Healthcare professions (like Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy and Paramedic)
- Nursing and Midwifery
- Health and Social Care professions (like adult care, social work or community support work)
- Education professions (primary, secondary or Further Education teaching)
- Humanities professions (English, Psychology and History)

We also have full level 3 pathways for Learning Support and Childhood Studies through the Diplomas in Specialist Teaching Support and Working with Children and Young People.

The Diplomas are made up of subject sets. Each set contains an introductory unit to the subject, deeper learning in related themes to prepare you for assignments, an independent research project and exam. The subject sets generally take around 6 months to complete and you will complete 2 subject sets. You will also undertake mandatory units covering study skills and academic writing. You will need to attend classes for 2 to 2 ¹/₂ days per week.

Say you want to get a job but you don't have the right qualifications - or experience what could you do? You might still be at school and keen to leave but feel you can't. Or you may have left and have no prospects.

Two words might help you: traineeships and apprenticeships. Both could offer you a future.

You might not realise it, but even if you're at school you could still choose another route, and apply for either a traineeship or an apprenticeship. The key is to be still learning.

AINFFSHIPS

A traineeship is a placement with a business, organisation or company to get you ready for work or further development. You have to be between 16 and 24 years old.

This might be a good option for you if you have applied for apprenticeships or work and haven't been offered a place. It could be that people have felt that you're not guite ready for work. It could even be that you're not really sure yet what you want to do.

A traineeship gives you the opportunity to get ready for work. You would:

- Do off the job classes in English, Maths, ICT and employability •
- Receive a personal coach and mentor
- Attend work experience with a great local employer •
- Be able to try more than one occupation at a time •
- Have the chance to show an employer what you are made of
- Be able to fast track to an apprenticeship, you'll be apprenticeship ready by the end of the programme

Traineeships last from between one and sixth months – and they don't affect your benefits. You would not normally be paid but you may be eligible for financial help, and help with your child care and travel.

The key thing about traineeships is that they prepare you for work or apprenticeships. They help you to build confidence and to understand the skills and behaviours that employers are looking for.

All vacancies are advertised online. All applicants will get a one to one guidance interview to help find the perfect traineeship and prepare you for an employer interview. APPRENTICESHIPS

Apprenticeships are on the job training opportunities.

They are often the best way into work since they give you the chance to work with an employer, to understand their business and to develop your skills at the same time. They're perfect for people who learn by doing rather than by studying.

They give employers the chance to see where your future lies when your apprenticeship is completed. What's more, you earn while you learn. Apprentices can earn upwards of **£100 a week**.

You would:

- Receive a personal lecturer who will guide you through the programme

I wasn't sure what I wanted to do when I left school, but I knew I wanted something practical, physical, outside work. I'm a big strong lad and I've always liked grafting and getting a sweat on.

Construction! That's what I wanted. I'll be a brickie or a joiner, maybe. Hard work, good wages.

I started a study programme in construction skills and as part of it I did a taster in working on the roads and highways. I'd never really thought about road works and highway maintenance but thought I'd give it a go.

It was really useful and led me in to the opportunity to apply for a highways job with the Council. I managed to get an interview and was offered a position. Now suddenly I'm getting paid while I work and I am still learning too. I really took to it and felt like I'd become part of a busy, hard-working team. One year later and I'd successfully completed the level 2 qualifications I wanted and moved on to being an advanced student. It sounds good to say that to my mates.

Things are more challenging at Level 3 but I've stuck to it and am really giving it my all.

Being reliable, listening carefully to instructions, taking responsibility, taking care, taking pride in my work – all these things have become second nature to me. I've made a good enough impression to secure a full time permanent job.

You'd think that would be the end of it, but it's not. The Council must see potential in me because they're now funding me to go to Uni and get qualified to become a Highways Inspector!

It's been a long road to get this far, but I can see an even longer future ahead.



If I can do it, anyone can - Christine, 19

When I was younger, I went to a mainstream school for a while. It didn't really work for me. I was eventually sent to a school a few miles away from where I lived. I was put in a taxi and taken to school and back. They mainly helped me get my English and maths sorted.

After I left school I went to a learning open day and met staff who worked with school children and babies in a nursery. I always wanted to work with babies and toddlers. I went away to find a voluntary placement in a village not far from where I lived. I had a police check done by the centre and started to work 3 days a week in a nursery.



Because of my slight learning disability I started on a basic award to learn to work with children. Me and my tutor thought it was best to start at the beginning and work my way up. I went to class every week and placement 3 days per week.

On a Tuesday my day off I decided to finish my maths and English which I started at my old school. They never did get it quite sorted. Anyway, I got lots of help and I passed my level 2. My mum was really pleased.

The placement was happy with me too because they said that getting the level 2 was the key to getting on the next course and they would give me the higher work to do to help me pass my course. I applied and got on to the level 2 qualification in child care.

I still went to class every week, still did my placement. But I got more responsibility in the placement working with the kids and learning what I needed to. We did all sorts with the children, storytelling, outings, wet and dry play with sand and water. Work was fun. I never thought I'd say that. The babies had a different room which eventually I got to work with when I was qualified.

My next step is to get to be a team leader in the nursery. I will get there. But I have higher hopes. Like a foundation degree.

That was the best thing I ever did, going to that open day.





OUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Adult Education Skills Courses

These courses are designed to help you build your professional and technical skills or get a second chance at education if you haven't succeeded in learning before. Courses help you to return to work, or prepare you to go on to higher level studies. All of our skills courses involve assessment for a nationally recognised qualification like awards, certificates, diplomas, GCSE's, A Levels and Access to Higher Education Diplomas. You are expected to take any assessment if you enrol for these courses. These courses are funded by the government and we can offer fee remission for certain groups of people. **Fees are marked in blue where you can take an Advanced Learning Loan**.

Community Learning

These courses are designed to help you learn for leisure and pleasure, build your skills in hobbies or interests, or it may be your first experience of learning in a long time and you want to get back into the swing of studying. It is a great place to start if you want to progress on to a skills course. There are also some clubs and groups. Some groups are self-programming where there is no leader and group members teach and support each other. Other clubs and groups are just like traditionally taught courses and will have a tutor. They attract no government subsidy so we cannot offer free fees for any of these activities. **Fees are marked in red where we cannot offer free fees.**

How do I enrol?

Most of our courses are open enrolment. For some of our courses at higher levels you will need to apply for the course and we may need to talk to you about your suitability for the course. If this is the case we will let you know when you contact us to enrol.

You can enrol by telephone or in person at any of the local centres.

How do I pay?

You can:

- Pay for your course by debit or credit card, cash or cheque. You need to
 pay your fees in full before classes start.
- Apply for an instalment arrangement where fees exceed £150.00: ask about our terms and conditions at any centre.
- Apply for an Advanced Learning Loan if you are 19+ and studying at level 3 or higher. The full conditions for applying for and repaying a loan can be found at https://www.gov.uk/advanced-learning-loans. You must have a loan in place before you start the course or you may be charged the full fee. If you need help with an Advanced Learning Loan, please call Gemma Lee on 01670 622105
- Apply for fee remission. On adult education skills courses we offer free study if you are in one of the groups listed below. You must provide proof of entitlement before you start or the offer of your place will be withdrawn. The following learners are entitled to free study during 2016/2017:

16-18 years at the start of the course

19-24 years and undertaking a Traineeship

 $19+\mbox{ and studying Functional Skills in English or Maths learning aims up to Level 2$

19+ and studying GCSE English Language or Maths learning aims and you do not already possess a grade C or higher in the subject

19-23 years studying to progress to level 2 (e.g. Entry Level or Level 1 and have not yet achieved above Level 1)

19-23 years and studying first full Level 2 qualification, where you have not already achieved at Level 2 or above

19+ years who are studying up to and including Level 2 who are unemployed and meeting one of the following conditions:

- receiving Job Seekers Allowance
- receiving Employment Support Allowance and are in the Work Related Activity Group
- receiving Universal Credit, either earning less than £330 a month or are determined by Jobcentre Plus (JCP) as being in one of the following groups: All Work-Related Requirements Group, Work Preparation Group, Work-Focused Interview Group

At our discretion we may provide you with fee remission if you are:

- unemployed and receiving any state benefit and earn less than £330 a month, want to enter employment and where the course is directly relevant to your employment prospects and the local labour market needs.
- employed but earn less than £330 a month and you need to progress into more sustainable employment and the learning is directly relevant to employment prospects and the local labour market needs. An example of where we may support your fees is if you are on a zero hours contract earning less than £330 a month and you undertake vocational training for an occupation.

All other learners are expected to pay fees in full or if you are 19+ and studying at level 3 or higher, you can apply for an Advanced Learning Loan.

What financial help is available?

The service has financial bursary schemes for 16-18 year olds and discretionary learner support funds for 19+. Schemes can help with the costs of learning including fees, materials and resources, travel, childcare and other costs. We are registered with the National Union of Students (NUS) which enables all our students to purchase an NUS card to benefit from a massive range of discounts.
