Not sure if we have enough from our pot, may need more funding.

KF queried if Northumberland is underfunded.

AC confirmed that the DFE new website released before christmas regarding other LA's showed us as being average in some tables so quite lowly funded so expect to gain.

Gains tempered due to increase in NIN.

Money not extra, redistributed where need is.

DFE published who gets more than others but doesn't detail need for maintained schools.

We come out average but individual schools will be affected in different ways.

A big change is the lump sum. Under the NFF proposals all schools irrespective of phase will receive £110k.

AC confirmed that a SEN exercise for High needs places is done yearly. New for 2017/18 is that the DfE will pay for first 10k for places in non maintained special schools but will not deduct the funding from the High Needs Block Additional places treated the same? This still needs to be confirmed. AC to check.

Local strategic planning for SEN and disability provision chapter 4, pg2 (Summary document)

All LA's directive is to complete a strategic review or a new one in 2017 and formerly publish results, want to know a plan. Key things - all to be done and 2-3 terms to complete is given. Look at this for review.

Free Schools for SEN - lots of terms and conditions. AC confirmed that a bid has been put in for the South East of the County for 120 place Primary Autism and Social and Mental Health free school.

We require 4.

DFE to look at proposal if they agree they will put the bid forward.

SEND National Capital fund pg 3:-

£200 million - not explained yet (Hope to find out in the Spring)

Contracts, pg 4:-

12 months of hard work for whoever gets the bid.

Quality of work places to be available, regular and larger workplaces.

Be bespoke for children with different needs.

Training for teachers for Autism...

Progression framework for autistic children.

Government intent is to have larger SEN schools, more alternative provision and mainstream, advice training for staff and preparation work for high need places.

Issue limited funding.

Outcome of AEN meeting, need all to understand and read the consultation document, schools, colleges etc. May need a LA position on this for responses to be useful. Joint response initially suggested.

AC proproses SEN lead on mainstream specialist units.

Need to create 300-500 extra places. Have created 50% extra over the years.

It was commented that this sounds reasonable, reform good intent but no money. Government initiative but need money to back it up is the issue.

Take into consideration 17,18,19 year olds for workplaces currently have restrictions.
