	<ul> <li>Patterns of buy in: <ul> <li>13 no</li> <li>63 yes</li> </ul> </li> <li>87 no response/tbc/under discussion with single school or group of schools.</li> <li>Some buy-in from independent sector, care sector and further work to be carried out with FE/adult education sectors.</li> </ul>	

	A further round of confirmations will be received this week, as many schools have their budgets and SLA buy-in signed off by the governing bodies.	
	<ul> <li>Positive buy-in characteristics:</li> <li>Individual schools of different sizes not in deficit.</li> <li>Very small schools on bespoke basis.</li> <li>Groups of schools with strong local partnership.</li> </ul>
