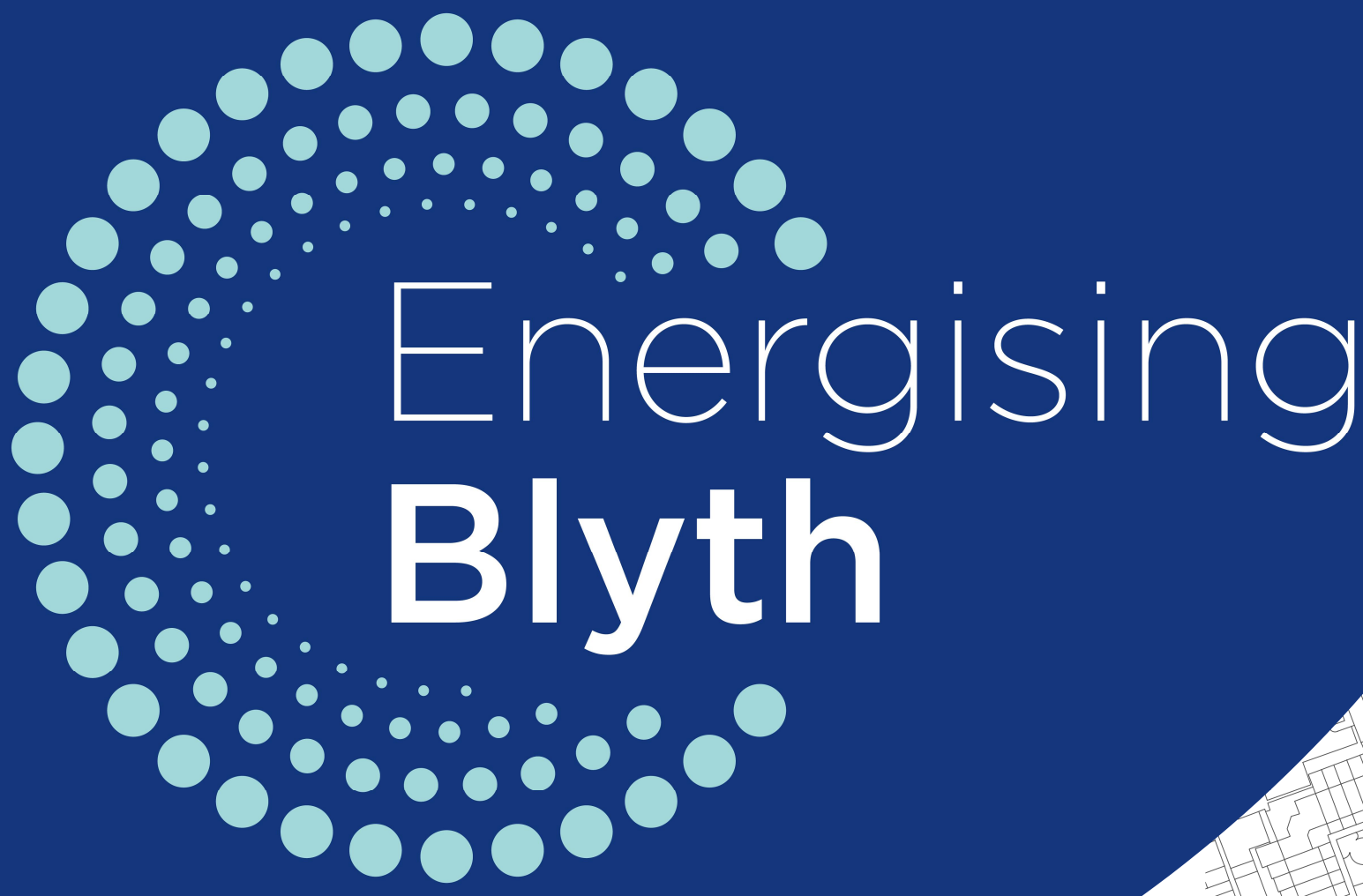


Quay Road, Eastern Gateway - Overview



Objective 1

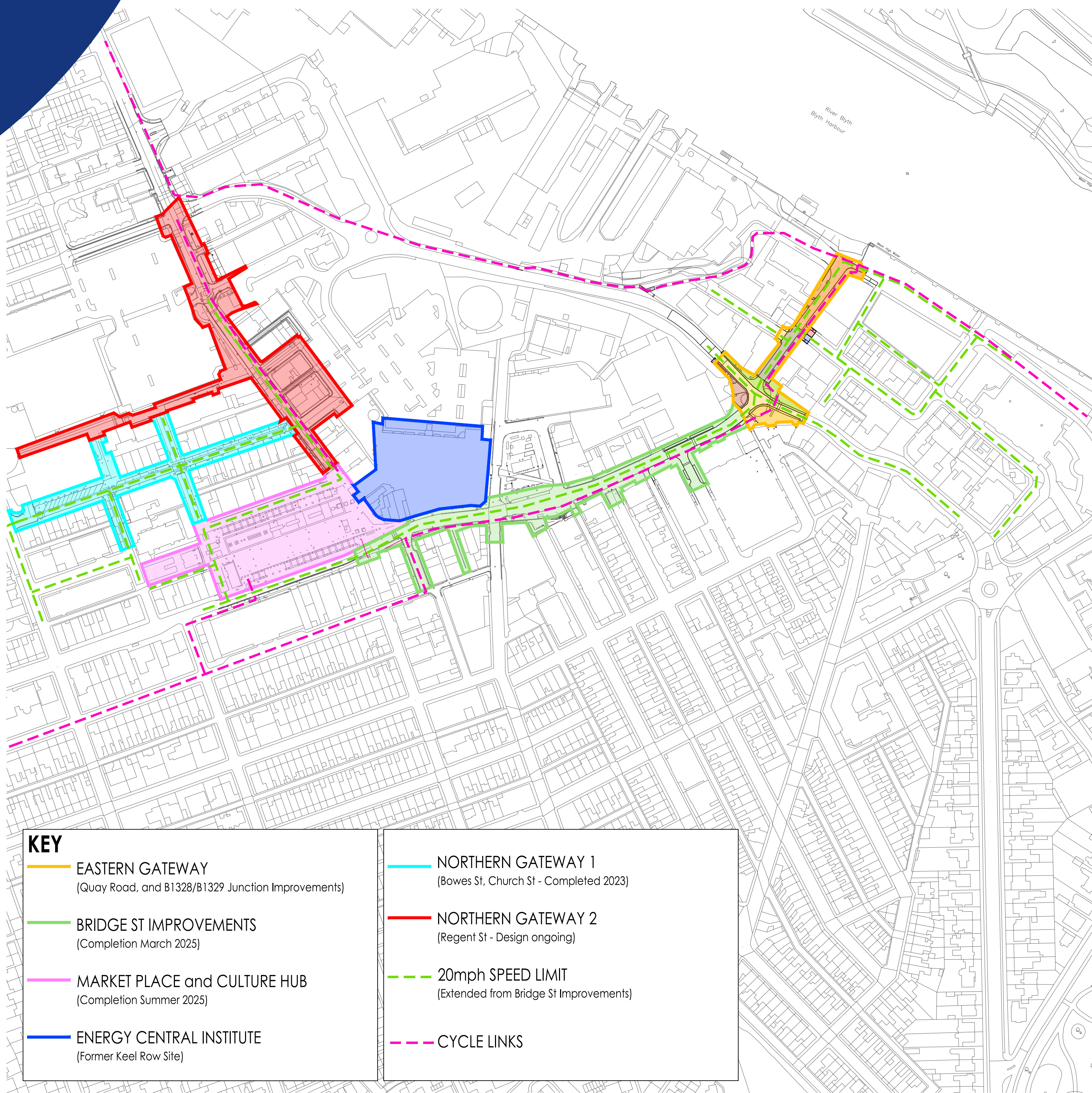
Create a more welcoming, accessible entrance to the town centre

Objective 2

Improve the quality of walking & cycling routes between Blyth town centre & the Quayside

Objective 3

Increase active travel and reduce car journeys



VISION

The project will improve cycleways, footpaths, roads and public space, enhancing access to Blyth Town Centre from the East. Works at Quay Road will connect the town centre with the Quayside via the new cycling/walking improvements being carried out on Bridge Street

CONSTRUCTION PHASING PLAN

The works will be delivered across 5 Phases in order to minimise disruption. There will be temporary road and footway closures during each phase to allow works to be carried out safely and efficiently.

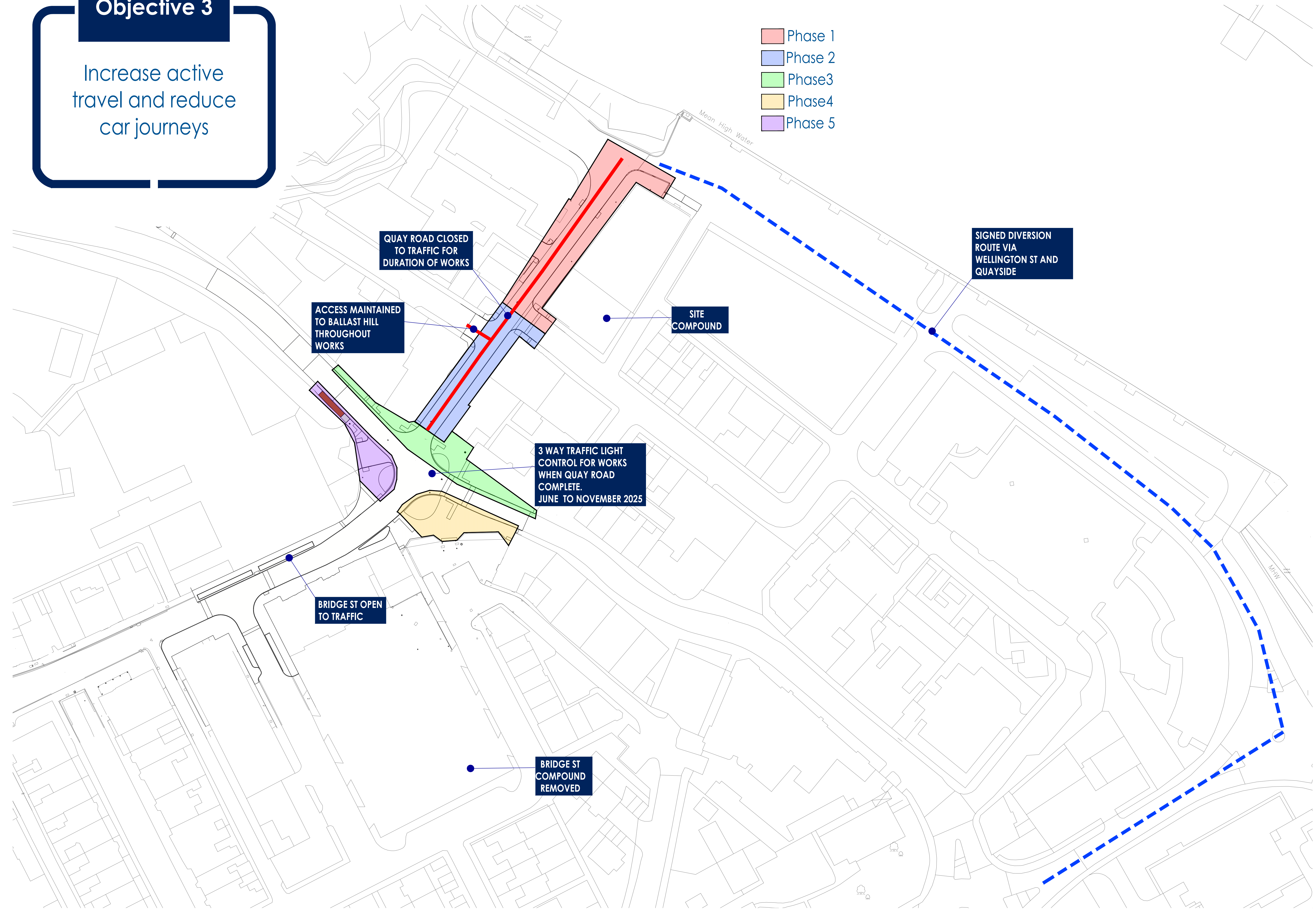
- Phase 1 and 2 works will take place on Quay Road which will be closed to motor vehicles.
- A local diversion will be in place.
- Alternative arrangements will be in place for pedestrians which will be clearly signed.
- Access will be provided for businesses located at Ballast Hill.
- Residents located on Sussex Street, Brewery Street, Plessey Road are asked to use the diversion in place on the Quayside.
- Police and Ambulance station access will be available at all times from the Quayside.

Updates on future phases of work will be provided as works progress. Updates will be provided on the NCC website and via letter drops to local residents and businesses. Traffic Management signage will be in place to notify motor vehicle users of changes.

March 2025 – Construction works commence (estimated up to 35 weeks, weather permitting)

Autumn 2025 – Practical Completion
