Overview

Through the **Borderlands Place Programme** https://www.borderlandsgrowth.com/"> , Northumberland County Council intend to target investment in places that will help boost economic activity across the region. Recognising the importance of our smaller rural market and coastal towns to the local economy, the Place Programme will support a range of capital interventions targeted at enhancing the economic infrastructure needed to ensure the sustainability and growth of our towns. Each town, including Bedlington, will be developing an investment plan to secure up to £3m of Borderlands Place Programme funding.


A series of Place Plans will be developed for both Bedlington and Northumberland's other priority towns. Towns will only enter the Place Programme should their Place Plan contain projects eligible for Borderlands investment.
