Overview

Through the Borderlands Place Programme https://www.borderlandsgrowth.com/, Northumberland County Council intend to target investment in places that will help boost economic activity across the region. Recognising the importance of our smaller rural market and coastal towns to the local economy, this programme will provide up to £50 million across the whole Borderlands region.
