Strategic Briefing

What is this?

As part of the inspection process, all English Fire & Rescue Services are given the opportunity to deliver a briefing to their core inspection team. The Strategic Briefing is our opportunity to set out the challenges the service faces, future plans, areas of good practice and areas we have identified as requiring improvement to our HMI (Matt Parr) and his team. The briefing is also an opportunity for Matt Parr and his team to ask questions for further discussion and clarification. This is expected to last approximately 3 hours.. Again, as with all engagements with the HMICFRS, this is another opportunity for the Inspection Team to get to know us better.

When is this?

The original date, which was released in last week's Friday Update, has since changed. We will now deliver our Strategic Briefing on Thursday the 18th of October 2018. This is a little over a week before an Inspection Team visit us for the fieldwork phase during the week commencing on the 29th of October.

Who will be involved?

From the HMICFRS, we are expecting HMI Matt Parr along with a select few of the Inspection Team, to be attending. From NFRS, as this is looking at a strategic level, the presentation will be delivered primarily by the Principal Officers with input from other members of the Senior Leadership Team where relevant.
