

HMICFRS Inspection - Friday Update 2

Inspection Data Request

Data Request - Background

HMICFRS has sent a data collection request to all English Fire & Rescue Services to help inform and support the inspection process. This may also advise the inspectorate when forming Key Lines Of Enquiry (KLOE) for each service prior to the inspection.

When Will NFRS Submit Data?

We already have, the first data request was received on the 3rd of April and was returned by the deadline on the 4th of May.

What Data Is Being Collected?

HMICFRS will be requesting data which helps support the inspection of each of the three principal FRS inspection question areas: effectiveness, efficiency and people. This includes data already provided to the Home Office (via the Incident Recording System and the Operational Statistics Data Collection) and to CIPFA (financial data). Some of the additional data provided includes:

- Home Fire Risk Check content;
- Number of high risk premises;
- Availability of fire appliances;
- Complaints from the public or businesses;
- Staff sickness;
- Fitness test details;
- Income generation.

Will There Be Any Further Requests?

Yes absolutely!! It is anticipated that there will be a minimum of 3 data requests in 2018 before moving to twice yearly data collections from 2019 onwards.
