Fieldwork Week Is Upon Us....

What does this mean?

The Fieldwork Week is the most intensive part of the inspection process, it also signifies that we are drawing nearer to the end of our first HMICFRS inspection. During this week the final interviews, focus groups and reality tests will be completed. Following this, the Inspectors will consolidate all evidence gathered since the start of the process in order to produce a final report and judgement on the Service. The report will be published for the public around May next year.

Is that it?

Although the future funding of the HMICFRS is yet to be agreed, it is highly likely that these types of inspections will become common place and will happen on a regular basis. This means that, going forward, we need to be 'inspection ready' and improve the Service by learning from any recommendations made in the forthcoming report.
