NFRS Hot Debrief

What is the Hot Debrief?

The Hot Debrief is a presentation delivered to the service by HMICFRS. This presentation will focus on some of the initial findings from their inspection process, going back from early 2018 up until the fieldwork last week. This presentation will give some indication of the areas which will be covered in the public report to be released in May, however, as all the evidence gathered will undergo further scrutiny and moderation by the central HMICFRS team, some areas of the debrief may not reflect the final report and so it will not include any indication of the final judgements or gradings. The debrief is an opportunity for us to take some learning from the process without waiting several months for the report to be released.

Who will be delivering the presentation?

The presentation will be delivered by our Service Liaison Lead, Matt Reavill whilst being supported by the Deputy Service Liaison Lead, Davinder Johal and the HMICFRS Northern & Eastern Chief of Staff, Mick Mason.
