

FIRE WARDEN COURSE

Learners will build upon their existing skills and knowledge of fire safety, developing a greater appreciation of fire behaviour and understanding the roles and responsibilities expected of the fire warden.

Course Content

- Relevant legislation
- Risk assessment and fire protection
- The role of the Fire Warden
- Action and responsibilities in the event of a fire
- Principles of evacuation & fire drills
- Practical search and evacuation exercise

FIRE AWARENESS COURSE
