

Lyndon Walk accommodation and facilities

The design of the bungalows is based broadly on the principles developed by Stirling University including the following:

Bathrooms

- Wet rooms with non-slip flooring
- PIR (motion activated) lighting in bathroom with override facility
- Mirrors with roller blinds
- Contrasting toilet seat
- Main bedroom has line of sight to 'Jack and Jill bathroom'
- Lever taps.

Kitchens

- COSH lockable cupboard under sink
- Lockable medicine cabinet
- Halogen hob
- Strong contrasting cupboards and work surfaces
- Under cupboard lighting
- Non reflective surfaces avoided
- Lever taps.

General

- High UV levels throughout
- Widened doorways and turning circles for wheelchair users
- Pull cords for telecare in bathroom and main bedroom
- Line of sight from living room to kitchen and bathroom
- Easy to use locks and door handles
- Two-way telecare screens in all units

- Internal front door different colour to other internal doors
- Heat and fire detection linked to telecare
- No doormat wells at front doors
- High level water stop cock
- PIR external lighting at front door.

Garden

- Private garden to each bungalow with gate into shared sensory garden
- PIR lighting in private garden and on entering shared garden
- All berried plants to be edible
- Planting to be sensory
- Outside seating in shared garden with looped pathway design.
