#### Details of Change

The branch surgery run by the White Medical Group, at 12, Grange Road, Stamfordham closed on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018. This branch surgery dispensed to approximately 350 patients who live in the Stamfordham area. Arrangements have been made to deliver medicines to these patients from the main surgery in Ponteland, which also dispenses to patients who live more than a mile away from a pharmacy. The other branch surgery in Stamfordham, operated by the Scots Gap practice remains open.

This change does not impact on the availability of pharmaceutical services in the Stamfordham area. The map in the PNA published on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 has been updated to reflect this closure.
