Details of Change

Boots Ltd applied to consolidate two branches by continuing to provide services from 1, Station Street, Bedlington NE22 7JN and closing its branch at 6, Station Road, Bedlington. Consolidating the two pharmacies will not create a gap in pharmaceutical service provision for the following reasons:

- ☐ The HWB does not oppose the application as it would not create a gap in service provision.
- ☐ The two sites are located in the same area, at a short walk (75 yards) from each other;
- ☐ The remaining pharmacy at 1 Station Street offers greater opening hours;
- ☐ Patients will continue to have choice of provider between 1 Station Street, another Boots pharmacy and two other providers in the area.

This change does not impact on the availability of pharmaceutical services in the Bedlington Station area. The map in the PNA published on 1st April 2018 will be updated to reflect this closure.
