- 2. Aside from the way the photo replicates the original, we will use the following criteria to judge the entries:
  - a. Impact
  - b. Creativity
  - c. The story it tells
  - d. Technical quality
  - e. Focus
  - f. Use of colour
  - g. Lighting
  - h. Composition
  - i. Points of interest
  - j. Style

- The competition will close on Monday 16 January 2023.
- Entries to be emailed to <u>mylibrary@northumberland.gov.uk</u>, attaching the entry form and your photographs. Please label your photographs clearly with the "Then" photograph numbers.
- You can submit one "now" entry per original Gibson photograph. You can therefore submit up to 5 entries.
- Winning entries will be published online in a Then and Now Photography exhibition.
- By entering this competition you give permission for Northumberland Libraries, Northumberland Archives and Northumberland County Council to publish your photograph/s online as part of the competition.
- Winning entries will also be published on social media. Your photograph/s may also be used on Northumberland Libraries, Northumberland Archives and Northumberland County Council's social media channels including Facebook, Twitter and Instagram, and on the Libraries website.
