## Notice of seizure

## **TAKE NOTICE** that

- Northumberland County Council of County Hall, Morpeth, NE61 2EF ("the Council") is the seizure authority for the purposes of regulation 2 of the 2015 Regulations and has seized a silver Suzuki Grand Vitara registration number SY53 NKZ together with its contents ("the seized property").
- The seized property was seized at 0330 hours on Tuesday 13 August 2019 at Emmerson Road, Newbiggin-by-the-Sea, Northumberland.
- The seized property was seized under the Council's powers under section 34B of the 1990 Act in respect of a relevant offence under section 33(1) of the 1990 Act.

- A person may make a claim of entitlement to seized property, beginning with the date of seizure and ending **15 working days** after the date of this Notice.
- A claim of entitlement must be accompanied by sufficient evidence to enable the Council to make a determination of entitlement and must include:
  - (a) the claimant's name, address and proof of identity;
  - (b) where an agent is acting on behalf of a claimant, the information referred to in paragraph 6(a) above together with proof of

- authority to act as an agent; and
- (c) where the claimant purports to be the registered keeper of the vehicle, the registration document
- 7 The Council may sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of seized property following publication and service of this Notice and -
  - (a) the claim period referred to in paragraph 5 has ended and no claim has been made;
  - a claim is made within the claim period but the Council has not determined that the claimant was entitled to the return of the seized property; or
  - (c) a duty to return the seized property arose but has ceased in accordance with regulation 19 of the 2015 Regulations.
