Druridge Bay Campsite terms and conditions

General

- The site is managed by Northumberland County Council.
- The campsite is available for holiday or recreational purposes only.
- The campsite is primarily intended for short stay tourists (maximum stay is 20 nights).
- Customers should arrive between 2pm noon and 5pm on day of arrival and the pitch must be vacant by 10:30am on the day of departure.
- Site charges are payable in advance through online booking.
- There will be no subletting permitted.
- Caravans and cars should be parked and tents pitched in the places allotted. Customers may be requested to move at times during the stay.
- The contents of all chemical closets and other waste-water shall be disposed of only at the disposal point provided.
- All refuse should be placed in the bins provided.
- Noise must be kept to a minimum after 10pm and before 7am.
- Dogs & other pets must be kept under proper control at all times.
- The lighting of camp fires is forbidden; only safe use of raised barbeques permitted on site. Wilful damage of surrounding trees and shrubs will result in immediate dismissal.
- Water sports on Lady Burn Lake is permitted through the purchase of a permit, from the café.
- The Northumberland County Council will not be responsible for the loss or damage to persons or property incurred while on site, however caused.
- The larger surrounding site, Druridge Bay Country Park, may be hosting events at time of visit.
- Authority for the conduct of the site is vested in the site warden.
- Site accommodation provided is conditional on all campsite rules being strictly observed and upon campers conducting themselves at all times with due regard to the comfort of others.
