Designation of Conservation Areas: Wall, Acomb, Ovington, Newton, Horsley, Northumberland

Notice is hereby given that Tynedale District Council has designated the area referred to in the Schedule to this notice as a Conservation Area under Part II, section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

The effect of the designation is that:

- (a) The Council will give special attention to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character and appearance of the Conservation Area.
- (b) Anyone wishing to demolish a building within a Conservation Area must apply to the District Council for Conservation Area Consent.
- (c) Anyone wishing to cut down, top, lop or uproot a tree situate within a Conservation Area must give 6 weeks prior notice of his/her intention.
- (d) Any application for development or demolition which, in the opinion of the Local Planning Authority, would affect the character or appearance of the Conservation Area will be advertised and any representations received will be taken into account in determining the application.

SCHEDULE

(a) *Wall, Conservation Area*

The Conservation Area comprises all land and buildings lying within the black line indicated on the deposited plan. The area includes all properties alongside Front Street, all properties north of The Chase and all those surrounding the Green and also includes the Primary School adjacent to the playing field.

(b) *Acomb, Conservation Area*

The Conservation Area comprises all the land and buildings within the black line indicated on the deposited plan. This area encompasses all properties and land on both sides of Main Street and The Green and also includes Oak Tree House, Hill Cottage, the Primary School and the School House.

(c) *Ovington, Conservation Area*

The Conservation Area comprises all the land and buildings lying within the black line indicated on the deposited plan. This area encompasses the farm and houses to the west and south of Ovington Hall and most properties on either side of the High Street in the eastern end of the village including the Social Club.

(d) *Newton, Conservation Area*

The Conservation Area comprises all land and buildings within the black line on the deposited plan. This area encompasses virtually all properties and land on both sides of the main street running through the village including Newton Town Farm and the Women's Institute.

(e) *Horsley, Conservation Area*

The Conservation Area comprises all land and buildings within the black line on the deposited plan. This area includes all properties and land fronting on to the Main Street from West End Cottage to East Holme. It also includes Horsley Banks, South East Farm and Croft Terrace. (728)
