SUGGESTED ITINERARY FOR INSPECTOR'S SITE VISIT*

Park at	Notes	Time
	Park and meet 9.00am at garage in Knowesgate , arriving at this point from the south. 5 mins	9.00am
A	Exit onto A689 north and take the next left, following signpost for Bellingham, West Woodburn and Kielder Water and Forest. Travel west along the road for about 2.5km. Park on the left side of the road just past Cornhills (take care as the road is narrow and traffic is often fast) (10 mins)	9.05am
	Access the public right of way (footpath) to the south of the road and observe Viewpoint 12 (10 mins)	9.15am
B	Continue west along the road and follow it as it turns to the north west and follow it for approximately 1km after this point. Park on the left side of the road (take care as the road is narrow and traffic is often fast) (5 mins)	9.25am
	Observe Viewpoint 4. (10 mins)	9.30am
C	Continue north west along the road for approx. 2.5km. As a point of interest Hepple Heugh, Cold Law and Hartside Cairn are evident along sections of this road from approximately 1km west of Parking Location B. Park to the left of the road close to the public right of way (footpath) from the east of Hepple Heugh leading to Great Wanney Crag. Park on the left side of the road (take care as the road is narrow and traffic is often fast) (5 mins)	9.40am
	Observe Viewpoint 1. (10 mins)	9.45am
D	Continue north west along the road for approx. 1km. Park in the layby to the right of the road as the road takes a 90 degree turn to the west (take care as the road is narrow and traffic is often fast – only space for 1 car) (5 mins)	9.55am
	Observe Viewpoint 2. (10 mins)	10.00am
	Walk 500m south east along the road (wearing PPE if required), to the proposed access point to the scheme and observe view from S1 (20 mins)	10.10am
	Enter the open access land walk north east to the site of the proposed car park to take in views from S2 towards Northumberland National Park and surrounding character area (20 mins)	10.30am

	Follow the proposed path route to the south of the proposals to take in view S3 to the north over Cold Law (30 mins)	10.50am
	Walk up to the summit of Cold Law to take in the character of the site in the context of its surrounding area and view S4 available from this location (30 mins)	11.20am
E	Travel west along the road and take a right onto the A68, taken the next right onto the road to East Woodburn. Pull over onto left hand side of road approx. 350m south of entrance to High Shaw (5 mins)	11.50am
	Observe Viewpoint 8 (10 mins)	11.55am
F	Follow the road north to East Woodburn and take a right turn, followed by and immediate left turn. Park in a safe place at crossroads with access track to Hartside. (5 mins)	12.05pm
	Observe Viewpoint 10 (10 mins)	12.10pm
G	Turn right and travel along track to Hartside, pull over onto left hand side of road opposite entrance to Harewalls (5 mins)	12.20pm
	Observe Viewpoint 7 (10 mins)	12.25pm
H	Travel back along the track and turn left at crossroads to head back to East Woodburn. Turn right and follow this road to the A68. Turn right onto the A68. Pull over into the layby loop on the left hand side of the road by Woodhouse (5 mins)	12.35pm
	Walk over to seating area in open space and Observe Viewpoint 13 (10 mins)	12.40pm
I	Turn left out of the layby and follow the A68 to the north. Pull over into the layby on the right hand side of the road just south of Corsenside Crossroads. (5 mins)	12.50pm
	Observe Viewpoint 14 (as originally requested by NNPA) (10 mins)	12.55pm

	LUNCH break (location to be determined) (30 mins)	1.05pm
J	Turn back onto the A68, heading south, and follow the route all the way to Ridsdale. At Ridsdale pull into the car park of the Public House. (5 mins)	1.35pm
	Cross to the east side of the road and observe Viewpoint 9 (10 mins)	1.40pm
K	Turn right onto the A68 and follow the road south for approx. 3km. Turn left onto the road to Sweethope Loughs. Approx. 150m to the west of the access to Sweethope Loughs pull over into a layby to the left of the road at the start of the public right of way (footpath) to Great Wanney Crag – only space for 1 car. (10 mins)	1.50pm
	Follow the footpath north to Great Wanney Crag and observe Viewpoint 15 (optional - 1 hour 20 mins)	2.00pm
L	Follow road eastwards and turn right into the entrance to Lunga Craggs and park in a safe place (5 mins)	3.20pm
	Follow the public right of way (footpath) south for approx. 750m and observe Viewpoint 11. (30 mins)	3.25pm
	Walk back to car. (20 mins)	3.55pm
	Estimated time of completion of site visit	4.15pm

	Optional Additional Viewpoint	
D	Park in the layby to the east of the road as the road takes a 90 degree turn to the west (take care as the road is narrow and traffic is often fast – only space for 1 car) (10 mins – if undertaken on same day as rest of route)	
	Walk 500m south east along the road (wearing PPE if required), close to the proposed access point to the scheme. Enter the open access land to the west of the road at the gateway where a sign is located highlighting the footpath route to Great Wanney Crag. Head in a south westerly direction over the open access land to locate a gap in the boundary wall, and then head in a westerly direction to the summit of Hepple Heugh. (40 mins)
