Regulation 77 application following prior approval (Conservation of Habitats and Species Regulations 2017)

Use this checklist to see what information you need to submit. This list applies from 1st July 2024. View The Conservation of Habitats and Species Regulations 2017 Regulations 75, 76 and 77.

Mandatory information requirements

Requirement	Guidance
Covering letter	There is no application form for this. Your covering letter or email must include:
	Your contact information.The site address.
	 Details of the development to be carried out. The planning reference number of the approved development.
Application fee	£30.
	Pay the fee on our secure online payments page. If you can include the payment reference with your covering letter this will help avoid delays.
Scaled location plan	This must show the proposed development. To find out what it should include see Note 3 of the national planning application requirements.
Floor plans	We only need the proposed floor plans. To find out what it should include see Note 8 of the national planning application requirements.

Nutrient budget	Only if your development will increase the number of people living or
	staying in the Lindisfarne or River Eden Nutrient Neutrality catchments.
	For example, a dwelling, holiday let or caravan. Sewage from
	development can increase nitrogen and phosphorus levels in rivers and
	waterbodies. This can cause nutrient pollution.
	Check if your site is in the Nutrient Neutrality Catchment on our
	constraints map.
	If it is, you must submit this document. See Note 30 of our local planning
	application requirements.

Copy of the opinion	If you have a response to your proposal from Natural England please
of appropriate nature	include it. You can find out how to get this in <u>regulation 76</u> .
conservation body.	
	You don't have to provide a response from Natural England to make a
	Regulation 77 application. We'll consult them as part of the application
	process so don't worry if you don't have one.

Other information we may need

We must carry out a Habitats Regulations Assessment when deciding a Regulation 77 application. We may ask you for further information to help us do this. It depends on the nature of the proposal and the nature of the protected site potentially being affected. We'll contact you if we need this.
