This application must be made by the relevant parish or town council wishing to apply to Northumberland County Council for the designation of a neighbourhood area. The submission of an application to the local planning authority is a requirement under The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 as a prerequisite to preparing a neighbourhood development plan or neighbourhood development order.

A map indicating the boundary of the proposed neighbourhood area must accompany this application.
