

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Embleton Neighbourhood Development Plan for the Embleton neighbourhood area

1. A Referendum will be held on Thursday, 10th June 2021 to decide on the question below:

"Do you want Northumberland County Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Embleton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"

2. Poll cards will be sent out to all residents of the Parish of Embleton who currently feature upon Northumberland County Council's Electoral Register. Residents who are currently registered to vote by post will be sent a postal vote pack.

3. Any residents of Embleton who are unsure as to whether they are registered or not or wish to register to vote by post or proxy should contact Electoral Services Northumberland County Council, County Hall, Morpeth, Northumberland, NE61 2EF or ring on 01670 624844 based on the deadlines set out below:

Application	Deadline for receipt
New applications to register to vote	Monday 24 May 2021
New applications to vote by post or to cancel or amend an existing postal/proxy vote	5 pm on Tuesday, 25th May 2021
New applications to vote by proxy	5 pm on Wednesday, 2nd June 2021
Applications for an emergency proxy vote on the grounds of physical incapacity or work/service reasons - The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 2nd June 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 2nd June 2021.	5 pm on Thursday, 10th June 2021
