NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA

Northumberland County Council hereby gives notice that North Sunderland Parish Council in partnership with the Civil Parishes of Bamburgh and Beadnell has submitted an application for the designation of a 'Neighbourhood Area' under Regulation 6 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

North Sunderland Parish Council is a 'Relevant Body' for the purposes of Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning. The proposed neighbourhood area covers the entire Parishes of Bamburgh, Beadnell and North Sunderland as shown on the map below:
