#### **NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA**

Northumberland County Council hereby gives notice that Ord Parish Council, in partnership with the Civil Parishes of Ancroft, Duddo, Holy Island, Horncliffe, Kyloe, Norham and Shoreswood, have submitted an application for the designation of a 'Neighbourhood Area' under Regulation 6 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

Ord Parish Council is a 'Relevant Body' for the purposes of Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning. The proposed Neighbourhood Area covers the entire parishes of Ord, Ancroft, Duddo, Holy Island, Horncliffe, Kyloe, Norham and Shoreswood as shown on the map below.
