

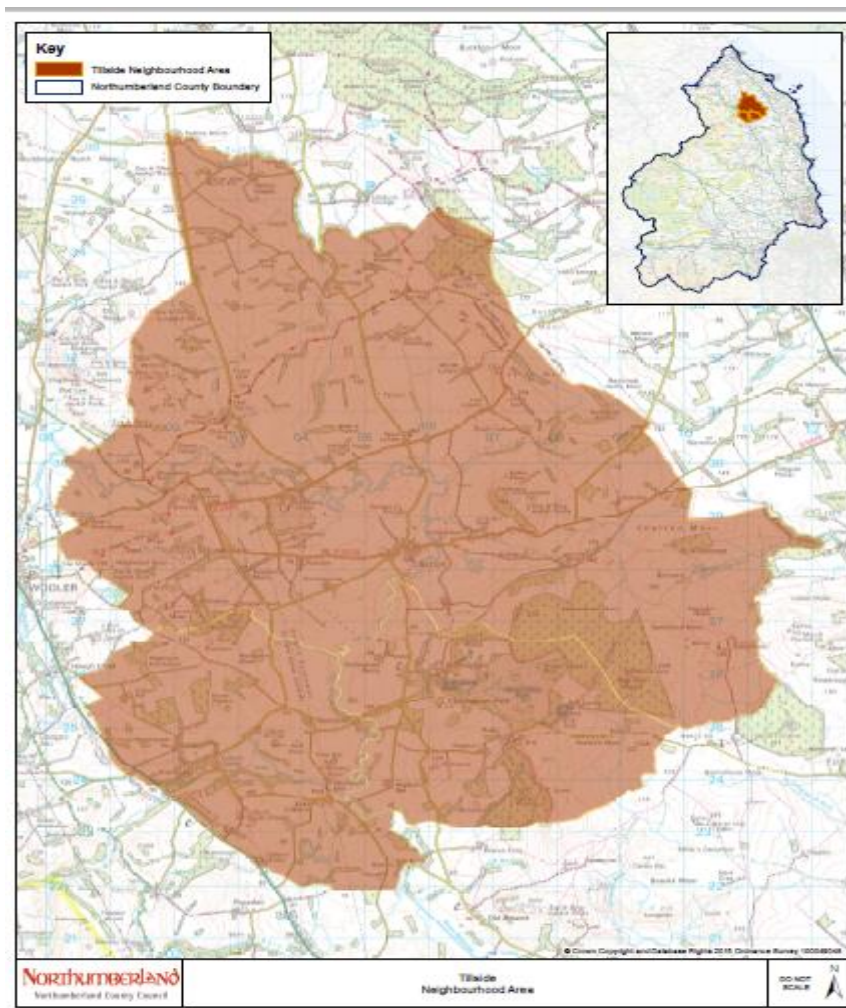

NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA

Northumberland County Council hereby gives notice that Tillside Parish Council has submitted an application for the designation of a 'Neighbourhood Area' under Regulation 6 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

Tillside Parish Council is a "Relevant Body" for the purposes of Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning. The purpose of the application is to enable Tillside Parish Council to undertake neighbourhood planning. The proposed Neighbourhood Area covers the entire Parish of Tillside, which comprises the Civil Parishes of Chatton, Chillingham and Lilburn, as shown on the map below.
