

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I GEOFFREY THOMAS BEAN of Broad Oak Farm, Hamsterley Colliery, Newcastle-Upon-Tyne, NE17 7QD DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows :-

1. I am and have been since March 1997 a co-owner of the land known as Broad Oak Farm, Hamsterley Colliery, Newcastle-Upon-Tyne, NE17 7QD ("my property") more particularly delineated on the Plan attached hereto marked "GTB1" and thereon edged yellow.
2. I am depositing with Northumberland County Council along with this Statutory Declaration a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by ~~blue~~ <sup>YELLOW</sup> edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said plan had been <sup>YTB</sup> dedicated as bridleways and the ways coloured red on the plan had been dedicated as footpaths. No ways have been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. There are no additional dedicated bridleways or footpaths affecting my property.
4. This declaration is made pursuant to Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980.
