

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I Sir Charles Burnett Bt DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:


- 1 I am and have been since 5 April 2004 the owner of the land known as Tillmouth Estate more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
- 2 On the 24th day of February 2012 I deposited with Northumberland Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways, the ways coloured yellow on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths.
- 3 No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 22nd February 2012 referred to in 2 above.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 19th day of March 2012 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.


