

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I, Vera Ann Maud Purvis, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

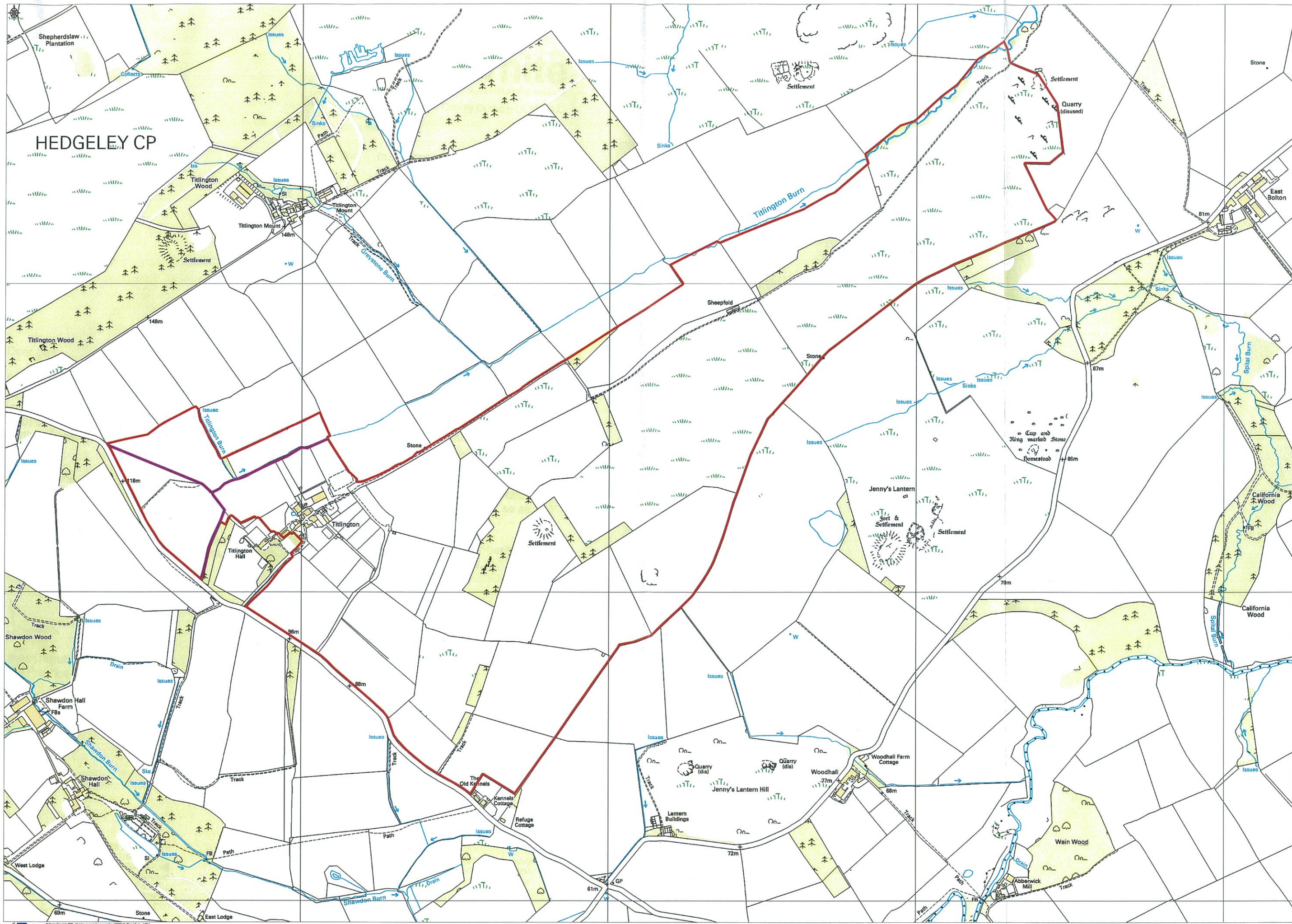
1. I am and have been since the 31st day of March 1987 the owner of the land known as Titlington Hall Farm, Alnwick, Northumberland, NE66 2EB more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 2nd day of April 2013 I deposited with Northumberland County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a map delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 23rd March 2013 referred to in (2) above other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the map accompanying this declaration and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 2nd day of April 2013 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
