Proposed Parking Restrictions – Acklington Road/Bisley Road, Amble

During the initial consultation, a number of requests were made regarding extending the restrictions further than originally proposed.

In view of this, the County Council is proposing additional double yellow lines in the areas highlighted red and blue on the plan overleaf. Please note, that these restrictions would be in force at all times, which means residents/visitors would not be able to park in these areas.


