Dear Resident,

Proposed Residents Parking Scheme, Monkside, Highburn, Southfield Gardens

Concerns have been raised by residents to County Councillor Mark Swinburn who are having difficulty parking near their homes due to indiscriminate parking by others. Therefore a permit parking scheme has specifically been requested.

I am writing to find out your views on providing residents permit parking in Monkside, Highburn and Southfield Gardens.

If a permit scheme is introduced, residents are entitled to two permits per household, one of which can be used by visitors. There is a charge of £25 per permit, per annum.

We would also welcome any feedback on what difficulties you are faced with, when the indiscriminate parking is occurring, and any other restrictions you'd like to see introduced in order to alleviate these problems.
