## **Proposed Traffic Calming Measures – Park Avenue.**

Due to an unfortunate printing error, the results from the most recent consultation cannot be included in the decision process. In the interest of fairness, I am consulting on the proposed traffic calming measures to Park Avenue once again. The proposal is for two speed humps on Park Avenue, one either side of Central Drive, the location and type can be seen on the attached plan.

Councillor Hutchinson has also asked me to make residents aware that parking on or near a speed hump is allowed. Should the results of the consultation be favourable, they would be installed as part of the 20mph school safety scheme. With the suitable placement of the speed humps being decided by liaising with the affected residents.

It should be stressed that this is a genuine consultation exercise and all comments received will be carefully considered. Comments are encouraged by email, responses should be sent to highwaysprogramme@northumberland.gov.uk, making the subject "Proposed Traffic Calming Measures – Park Avenue". For those who do not have access to emails, a freepost response form is attached to ease the consultation process.
