Proposed Residents Permit Parking, Lisburn Street/Prudhoe Street, Alnwick

Concerns have been raised with the County Council about indiscriminate parking in the above streets causing problems for residents. You may be aware of a survey that was recently carried out locally which showed that residents were generally in favour of implementing a resident's permit parking scheme.

A permit scheme would mean that only residents and their visitors could park. However, you should note the following:

- The current charge for Resident Parking Permits is £25 a year per permit.
- A maximum of 2 permits can be provided per household with one permit reserved for residents and one for visitor parking.
- A permit does not guarantee a parking space (note you do not need a permit to park on your own private driveway).
- A minimum of 75% of eligible residents must respond, and of those, 70% must be in favour of the scheme for this to proceed.
