Proposed Pedestrian Refuges and Parking Restrictions, North Road, Ponteland

The County Council is currently considering potential improvements on North Road designed to improve facilities for pedestrians and help reduce traffic speeds. The proposals include the provision of up to three pedestrian refuges to make it easier for pedestrians to cross the road.

In order for these potential crossing points to be kept safely clear of parked vehicles which would otherwise obstruct the view of pedestrians and possibly prevent vehicles from passing through, parking restrictions are necessary.

These restrictions would be double yellow lines to prevent parking at all times, including on the footway. The plans overleaf show the extent of the proposed double yellow lines.

I am therefore writing to you formally to ask for your views on these proposals before a decision is taken on whether to implement them or not.
