## **Proposed Experimental 'No Waiting at Any Time' Parking Restrictions, (Double Yellow Lines), Percy Terrace, Alnwick**

The County Council has received concerns about roadside parking on Percy Terrace which prevents vehicles from safely accessing or exiting South Street.

In order to address these concerns, it is proposed to provide double yellow lines as shown on the plan overleaf. It is intended to provide these lines on an experimental basis initially, in order to assess their effectiveness and to allow for the extent to be altered depending on the scale of the problem.

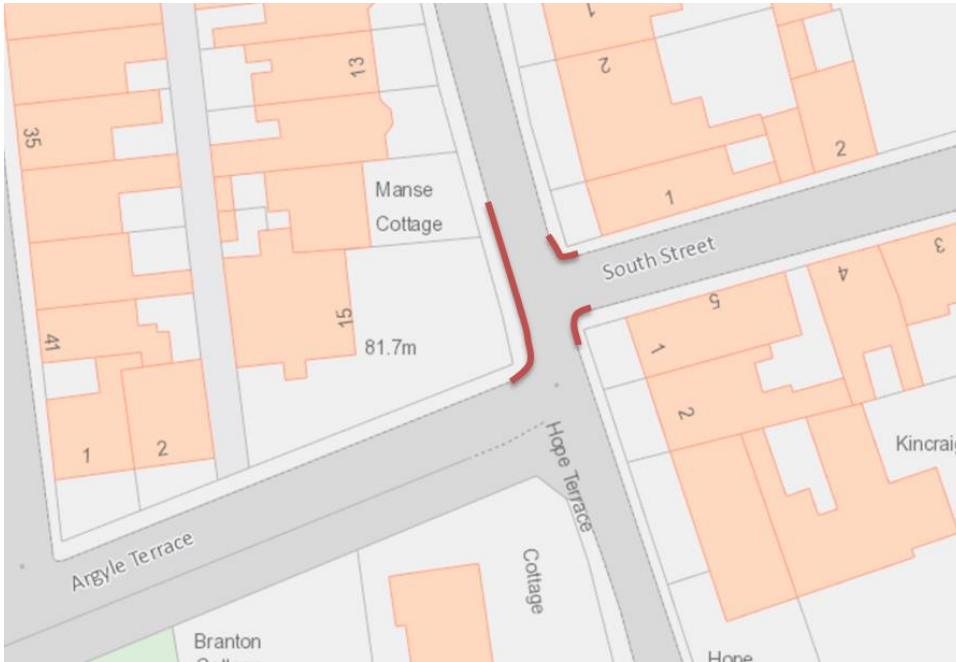
