Dear Resident,

Proposed Parking Restriction Removal – Wensleydale Terrace, Blyth

I am writing to inform you that Northumberland County Council intends to remove a short section of existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' (double yellow lines) parking restrictions directly outside residential properties on Wensleydale Terrace.

Vehicles would be permitted to continue parking on this section of footway as is currently observed, provided that obstructions to pedestrians are not occurring, however no parking would be permitted adjacent to any other sections of the footway or carriageway with double yellow lines still in place.

A drawing showing the proposed location and length of the parking restrictions to be removed is enclosed.
