Proposed Parking Restrictions – Wensleydale Terrace & Adjoining Junctions, Blyth

Northumberland County Council has received concerns regarding obstructive and indiscriminate parking at the junctions of Wensleydale Terrace and Dent Street, Grantham Street, Twizell Street and Briarwood Road. In order to address this, extended 'No Waiting at Any Time' (double yellow lines) parking restrictions are proposed.

A drawing showing the proposed location of the new parking restrictions is enclosed.


