RECORD OF DECISION TAKEN BY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF LOCAL SERVICES

PROPOSED EXTENSION OF 30MPH SPEED LIMIT - U9056 WHALTON

Purpose of report:

To consider the results of the consultation exercise, regarding the proposed 30mph speed limit extension on the U9056 in Whalton.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that in view of the consultation exercise, the 30mph speed limit should be extended as proposed.

Key issues

- Scheme being funded by Oakland Homes North East Ltd (developer of Whalton Manor Dairy).
- 2) The 30mph speed limit extension has been requested as a planning condition.

BACKGROUND

- In 2014, planning permission was approved to develop the Whalton Manor House Dairy site, Whalton. As part of a Road Safety Audit, recommendations were made to extend the existing 30mph speed limit, to ensure that the development was within this limit.
- 2) In April 2014, funds were secured from the developer in order to carry out those necessary works.
- 3) The proposed 30mph speed limit extension was the subject of a consultation letter to approximately 30 statuary consultees, including the emergency services and various disabled and transport associations/organisations. A plan showing the proposals is attached together with a copy of the consultation letter (see Appendix A)

CONSULTATION

4) The consultation exercise ended on 21st January 2015 and responses were received from 3 consultees, all in favour of the proposals. A summary of the responses is attached as Appendix B.

RECOMMENDATIONS

5) It is recommended that in view of the results of the consultation exercise, together with the requirement of the planning application, the 30mph Speed Limit should be extended as proposed.

You may wish to note that any comments received may be included in a Decision Report to be assessed by the Corporate Director of Local Services and may be available for public inspection.


