

RECORD OF DECISION TAKEN BY DIRECTOR OF LOCAL SERVICES AND HOUSING

PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS GOLF CLUB ROAD, BERWICK UPON TWEED 27 January 2016

Purpose of Report

To consider the results of the public consultation exercise, regarding proposed parking restrictions on Golf Club Road in Berwick upon Tweed.

Recommendations

It is recommended that:

1. It is recommended that the parking restrictions are amended on Golf Course Road Berwick upon Tweed. To change a small section of No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines) to Limited Waiting Parking Bays (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm Maximum stay 3 hours no return 4 hours).

Key Issues

- 1. There is a lack of parking spaces at this location for users of the local Bowling Club and visitors.
- 2. The Scheme is funded and supported by Councillor Gavin Jones

BACKGROUND

- 1. Concerns have been identified by Councillor Jones at the lack of parking facilities for visitors to the local bowling club.
- 2. It is proposed to reduce a section of the existing No Waiting at any time restrictions and replace with limited waiting parking.
- 3. It was felt that the proposed changes would not impact on road safety i.e. remaining restriction, width of road and visibility.
- 4. In addition, allow limited waiting parking adjacent to Bowling Club and this type of restriction allows a turnover of cars to use this parking facility.

CONSULTATION

- 5. These proposals were the subject of a consultation exercise that involved the delivery of a consultation letter to 1 resident/business (non-residential area) and 30 statutory consultees, including the emergency services and various disabled and transport associations/organisations. A plan showing the proposals is attached together with a copy of the consultation letter (see Appendix A).
- 6. The consultation exercise ended on 4th July 2015 and responses were received from 2 consultees, with one in favour and one against the proposal. A summary of the responses is attached an appendix B.

COMMENTS

- 7. The response against the proposal was received from Berwick Town Council however, there was no specific/valid reason behind this response. In view of the area (non-residential), responses received and Councillor support, there appears little benefit to re-consult on the proposal. It is therefore decided to proceed with the proposal.
- 8. Limited Waiting Parking Monday to Friday 08.00 am to 6.00 pm Maximum Stay 3 Hours No Return within 2 Hours as detailed in the consultation document has been changed to: No return with 4 hours. To facilitate more efficient enforcement by Parking Services. This change does not affect the consultation process.
- 9. Councillor Gavin Jones was notified of the results of the consultation and confirms he wishes to proceed with the proposal, which will be funded through his allocation in the Members' Local Improvements Programme.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 10. Although there was a low response to the consultation we have the full support of the local County Councillor and therefore it is recommend to proceed with the proposal i.e. changes to the parking restrictions.
- 11. The Council has the power to hold a public inquiry before making any traffic regulation order. Such an inquiry might enable disputed evidence to be tested under cross-examination and the need for an order to be critically examined by an independent inspector. In this particular case, officers believe that the extensive consultation process and involvement with interested parties, means that such an inquiry is unlikely to bring any fresh information to light and it is therefore recommended that an inquiry is not held.

Following the introduction of waiting and loading restrictions at the above location in 2013, anecdotal evidence has indicated that parking has continued to be an issue. The proposal is aimed to free up a section of parking, without being detrimental to the flow of traffic.


