Introduction of Experimental No Waiting Restrictions Beadnell Village 25 September 2018

Cabinet Member: Glen Sanderson - Environment & Local Services

#### **Purpose of Report**

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of new No Waiting Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at two locations in Beadnell Village on an experimental basis.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that the new No Waiting Restriction At Any Time (Double Yellow Lines), adjacent to The Wynding and Harbour Road/Benthall, Beadnell Village are introduced on an experimental basis. For a period of 12 months (reviewed after 6 months).

#### **Key Issues**

- 1. These changes are in response to a number of road safety concerns in relation to indiscriminate parking in the village, which have been raised by the Parish Council.
- 2. The scheme is supported by both County Councillor Renner-Thompson and Beadnell Parish Council.

#### **Background**

Beadnell Parish Council have raised concerns about indiscriminate parking in areas of Beadnell Village. This causes a number of road safety concerns, notably visibility at junctions and the fact that buses cannot negotiate their way through the village safely. Areas of particular concern are: The Wynding and Harbour Road/Benthall, Beadnell Village.

Following discussions between NCC Officers, County Councillor Renner-Thompson and Beadnell Parish Council, it has been decided to introduce No Waiting Restrictions At Any Time (Double Yellow Lines) on an experimental basis, for a 12 month period.

It is considered that this approach will allow for the restrictions to be monitored during peak and non peak periods and allow for any amendments to be carried out if required. An Experimental Order provides this flexibility, where feedback from road users is encouraged throughout the 12 month period, with a review taking place after 6 months.

Notification of these changes will be advertised as part of the legal process of making this Experimental Order, together with an article in the Village News, which is circulated in Beadnell and surrounding villages

Details of the proposals are shown on the plan in Appendix A.

Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the experimental Orders.

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


