### PROPOSED 30MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION, C80 BOULMER

Cabinet Member: Councillor Glen Sanderson

### **Purpose of Report**

To consider the results of the consultation exercise regarding a proposal to extend the 30mph speed limit on the C80 at Boulmer.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that the proposed 30mph speed limit extension is implemented.

#### **Key Issues**

The County Council has received concerns from local residents via the local Ward Member and Parish Council about traffic speeds in Boulmer.

#### **Background**

- 1. The County Council has received concerns from local residents via the local Ward Member and Parish Council about traffic issues in Boulmer.
- 2. Officers held a drop-in session in the Memorial Hall in Boulmer at which residents were able to discuss the various traffic issues in the village.
- 3. One of the main issues raised was the speed of traffic entering the village from Longhoughton and the fact that the start of the existing 30mph limit was very close to a tight right hand bend.
- 4. Following the drop-in session a number of potential solutions were identified which were subject to consultation with residents.
- 5. One of the proposals was to extend the 30mph speed limit on the C80 road by approximately 125 metres so that traffic is slowed in advance of the bend. This would also bring properties at Boulmer Hall within the 30mph limit.
- 6. It was also proposed to provide a 'gateway' style feature with combined 30mph village nameplate signs and granite setts.
- 7. Analysis of the consultation results showed that 14 of those who responded were in favour of extending the speed limit and none were against.
- 8. A formal consultation was therefore carried out with statutory consultees. Three responses were received: 2 in favour from Longhoughton Parish Council and Cycling UK, and 1 a standard response from the North East Ambulance Service with no concerns. The consultation Plan and responses are shown in Appendix A.
- 9. The Parish Council have subsequently confirmed their support for the provision of granite setts as part of the gateway feature.
- 10. The local Ward Member supports the proposal.
- 11. It is therefore recommended that the proposed 30mph speed limit extension should be implemented through the LTP programme.


