Proposed Craster Village, Introduction of new 20 MPH Speed Limit restriction

Purpose of Report

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of a new 20 mph speed limit in Craster Village. This proposal is included in the Local Transport Programme (LTP) Programme 2018/2019.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the new 20 mph Speed Limit is introduced in Craster Village, together with amendments to adjoining speed limits to compliment this scheme.

Key Issues

- Concerns were raised by the local community about the increased speed of traffic in the village.

Background

Craster Village is popular with tourists throughout the year and consequently traffic flows have increased over the years. This has lead to road safety concerns and in particular the speed of traffic in the village and surrounding area.

Officers have been working with the Parish Council and County Councillors for some time and a suitable scheme has now been agreed which meets the needs of the village, consisting of a 20mph speed limit within the village, the introduction of 40mph "buffer zones" and improved signage as necessary.

Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Orders.

Consultation took place between NCC Officers, Local County Councillor and Parish Council who full supported the proposals.

As part of this scheme it was proposed to introduce a "priority and give way signs" adjacent to Craster Clock Tower. However, this proposal has been withdrawn, as it is considered that the required signage would detract from this locally treasured listed building. NCC Officers will continue to monitor the road safety needs at this location.







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


