Proposed Introduction of new 20 MPH Speed Limit Restriction and Waiting and Loading Restrictions at Duchess's Community High School Alnwick

22 August 2018

#### **Purpose of Report**

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of traffic safety improvements for the new Duchess's Community High School, Alnwick.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that the new 20 mph Speed Limit is introduced. It is also recommended to introduce the previously agreed, highway requirements of the Section 278 and Section 38 conditions for the new school. These requirements include: Provision of Waiting and Loading Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) and Keep Clear Markings - No Stopping - (Yellow Zig-Zag lines) on Taylors Drive Alnwick, adjacent to the new school.

#### **Key Issues**

- 1. This report covers highway safety improvements required for the new Duchess's Community High School Alnwick.
- 2. The provision of 20 MPH speed limit adjacent to Duchess's Community High School Alnwick, in line with County Policy will help to improve

road safety in the vicinity of the new school. This element of the work will be funded through the Local Transport Plan.

3. Highway improvements are required as part of the Section 278 agreement for the development of Duchess's Community High School Alnwick. This element of the work will be funded by the developer.

#### Background

#### Introduction of 20 MPH Speed Limit

The introduction of a 20 MPH Speed Limit adjacent to Duchess's Community High School Alnwick is part of the 2018/19 LTP. This is part of the County Council's road safety initiative to introduce 20 MPH speed limits adjacent to all schools in Northumberland, provided it is feasible to do so.

Consultation took place between NCC Officers, Local County Councillors and the Town Council, who are all fully supportive of these proposals.

Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Orders.

A plan showing the extents of the 20mph speed limit is attached as Appendix A.

#### **Highway Conditions of Section 278**

Following the planning application for the development at Duchess's Community High School Alnwick, there were a small number of conditions which were required to improve safety on the Highway these include:-

- Waiting and Loading Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines)
- Keep Clear Markings No Stopping (Yellow Zig-Zag lines)

A plan showing the extents of these restrictions is attached as Appendix A.

The Emergency Services and other relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Traffic Regulation Orders.

It is anticipated the works for both schemes can be completed in October 2018 to coincide with the formal adoption of the Highway.
