Proposed Introduction of a Prohibition of Driving (Except for Cyclists) Low Greens Link Road, Berwick

14 March 2018

Purpose of Report

To consider the proposal to introduce a "Prohibition of Driving" (Except for cyclists) on U107 Low Greens Link Road, Berwick.

Recommendations

It is recommended that:

- 1. a "Prohibition of Driving" (Except for cyclists) traffic regulation order be introduced on U107 Low Greens Link Road, Berwick.
- 2. a planting box be placed at the west end of Low Greens Link road to augment the traffic regulation order.
- 3. No Through Road signs be erected as appropriate.
- the current 'No Waiting at any Time' parking restriction be revoked on Low Greens Link Road to provide additional on street parking for the residents parking scheme.

Key Issues and Background

- 1. This area has been highlighted by the Residents' Association as a safety concern.
- 2. The roads in Low Green area lead only to residential properties and terminate in footpaths which are used extensively by pedestrians as a route to the town centre. During a site inspection it was found that the roads were inadequately signed with respect to this dead end.
- 3. It was also noted that by removing the through traffic from one small section of highway, this would increase the safety of pedestrians and increase the on street parking for residents.

4. The scheme is funded and supported by Councillor Catherine Seymour through her Members' Local Improvement allocation.

Consultation

- 1. A formal consultation did not take place as this proposal is being introduced on traffic safety improvement grounds.
- 2. Support for the proposal is provided by both Councillor Seymour, and The Residents' Association. (See appendix B).
- 3. Statutory consultees have been notified.
- 4. Advertising of the scheme will be carried out via the legal process for the introduction of a new Traffic Regulation Order.

Recommendations

- It is recommended that the proposal as detailed in Appendix A, should proceed having the full support of the Residents' Association and County Councillor, including proceeding with the introduction of a No Through Road in Low Greens, Berwick.
- 2. The Council has the power to hold a public inquiry before making any traffic regulation order. Such an inquiry might enable disputed evidence to be tested under cross-examination and the need for an order to be critically examined by an independent inspector. In this particular case, officers believe that the process and involvement with interested parties, means that such an inquiry is unlikely to bring any fresh information to light and it is therefore recommended that an inquiry is not held.

Proposed Prohibition of Driving (except for cyclists) Low Greens Link Road, Berwick

The Greenses Resident Association, recently raised safety concerns with County Councillor Seymour, regarding the Link Road at Low Greens, Berwick. Following a site meeting where safety and residents parking issues were discussed, Councillor Seymour has agreed to fund the design and implementation of a scheme which will prevent vehicles from using this road.

It is proposed to introduce a Prohibition of Driving order on the Link Road and place a large planting box at the western end, with appropriate advanced warning signs. Pedestrians and cyclists will be unaffected by these measures. The Greenses Resident Association has agreed to maintain the planter. As the Link Road will no longer be subject to through traffic, it is also proposed to amend the current parking restrictions to provide extra on street parking for the residents parking scheme.

I am therefore writing in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 (as amended) to formally advise you on the proposed introduction of "Prohibition of Driving" traffic regulation order (except for cyclists) and the removal of 'No Waiting at any Time' parking restrictions at U107 Low Greens Link Road, Berwick, as shown on the attached plans.


