Proposed No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions, Main Street at its junction with Sea Road, Spittal, Berwick upon Tweed

Purpose of Report

To consider the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (Double yellow Lines) on Main Street, Spittal at its junction with Sea Road.

Recommendations

It is recommended that No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (Double yellow Lines) be introduced as proposed on Main Street, Spittal.

Key Issues

- 1. Indiscriminate parking occurs at the junction of Main Street with Sea Road, Spittal.
- 2. The scheme is to be funded by Councillor Hill, through her members' Local Improvement Allowance.
- 3. No objections to the proposal have been received.

Background

- 1. Residents contacted their local Ward member with concerns regarding inconsiderate drivers parking on or near the junction of Main Street with Sea Road, Spittal.
- 2. Indiscriminate parking at this junction is making it difficult for residents to negotiate the junction safely.
- 3. After meeting with Councillor Hill, Officers proposed that "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions be introduced at the junction in order to alleviate these concerns.
- 4. A consultation letter was sent to 5 residents and 18 statutory consultees on the proposed parking restrictions. A copy of the consultation letter and plan are attached in Appendix A.
- Two responses were received as a result of the consultation letter, with one in favour and one neither for nor against. No objections were received. A summary of the responses is attached as Appendix B.
- 6. The results were passed to Councillor Hill, who agreed that the No Waiting at At Time restrictions be introduced as proposed.
- 7. The scheme is funded and supported by Councillor Georgina Hill through her Members' Local Improvement Allocation.


