PROPOSED PARKING, RESTRICTIONS, ELSDON AVENUE, SEATON DELAVAL, (OUTSIDE ASTLEY HIGH AND WHYTRIG MIDDLE SCHOOLS)

Purpose of Report

To consider a proposal to provide parking restrictions on Eldson Avenue in Seaton Delaval, outside Astley High and Whytrig Middle Schools.

It is recommended that the proposed parking restrictions are implemented.

Key Issues

The County Council is working with Seaton Valley Parish Council and the schools located on Eldson Avenue, to improve road safety.

Parking restrictions are proposed as part of a wider scheme which includes the provision of a zebra crossing, in order to keep the road in front of the school clear of parked cars, especially at school start and finish times.

Delegated decisions

Background

- 1. The County Council is working with Seaton Valley Parish Council and the schools located on Eldson Avenue, to improve road safety.
- Parking restrictions are proposed as part of a wider scheme which includes the provision of a zebra crossing outside the school to enable children to safely cross the road. A copy of the proposal is shown in Appendix A.
- 3. In order to keep Elsdon Avenue clear of traffic at school times when children are present, single yellow lines are proposed. These will prevent parking from 8am to 9.30am and 2pm to 4pm.
- 4. Some double yellow lines are also proposed to protect the junction of Ridsdale Close from parked cars and protect visibility for vehicles entering/exiting.
- 5. The proposals have been agreed by the local ward Member, Seaton Valley Parish Council and representatives of both schools.
- 6. It is therefore recommended that the proposed parking restrictions are implemented.


