PROPOSED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME PARKING RESTRICTION ON FRONT STREET WEST, BEDLINGTON

Purpose of Report

To consider the introduction of no waiting at any time parking restriction on Front Street West in Bedlington due to road safety concerns.

Recommendations

It is recommended that a "No Waiting at Any Time" parking restriction is introduced on front Street West in Bedlington.

Key Issues

- Inconsiderate parking occurring on the Market Place due to a parking restriction being removed when resurfacing works took place and never being reinstalled in error.
- 2. Vehicles pulling on to the pedestrianised area of the Market Place which was not designed to take the loads imposed by vehicular traffic.
- 3. There are already adequate parking facilities in the town to accommodate any vehicles visiting the shopping outlets.

 Restrictions to be introduced without any formal consultation in order to address road safety concerns which have been raised by West Bedlington Parish Council and Local County Councillor

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PROPOSED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME PARKING RESTRICTION ON FRONT STREET WEST, BEDLINGTON

Background

- As part of the regeneration of Bedlington Market Place, alterations were made to the streetscape. In addition a number of parking restrictions were also changed. Regrettably, during these works a section of double yellow line failed to be reintroduced in error following resurfacing works associated with the Market Place Scheme.
- 2. In recent months a number of complaints regarding inconsiderate parking has increased significantly. Vehicles are parking on the Market Place area, which has now become dangerous for pedestrians. These actions are also causing damage to the pavement, despite adequate parking provision being available within the town.
- After discussing the complaints with West Bedlington Parish Council
 and Local County Councillors it was agreed that double yellow lines
 should be reinstated as originally planned without any formal
 consultation due to the restrictions being necessary on road safety
 grounds.

Consultation

The reintroduction of additional No Waiting At any Time parking restriction will be introduced without consultation due to significant road safety concerns in the area. The 30 statutory consultees including the emergency services and various disabled and transport organisations/associations will be informed of the decision as well as the Chief Officer of Police. A plan showing the proposals is attached as Appendix A.

Recommendations

- 4. From the outset, the County Council has endeavoured to respond positively to local concerns raised in this area and it is inevitable that some individuals in the community will be dissatisfied with whichever decision is reached. The introduction of parking restrictions without consultation can be a contentious matter, but due to the road safety concerns in the area and support from local County Councillor and Bedlington Town Council, it is recommended that the "No Waiting At Any Time" (double yellow line) is introduced on Bedlington Front Street West.
- 5. The Council has the power to hold a public inquiry before making any traffic regulation order. Such an inquiry might enable disputed evidence to be tested under cross-examination and the need for an order to be

critically examined by an independent inspector. In this particular case, officers believe that such an inquiry is unlikely to bring any fresh information to light and it is therefore recommended that an inquiry is not held.


