Introduction of new 20 MPH Speed Limit Restriction at Station Bank & Eastgate Bank in Mickley

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of a new 20 MPH speed limit at Station Bank & Eastgate Bank in Mickley .

Advisory "20mph when lights flash" signage is due to be introduced on the A695 at West Road, in the vicinity of Mickley First School.

This is part of the County Councils road safety initiative to introduce 20mph at all schools in Northumberland, provided it is feasible to do so.

To compliment this scheme, and the existing 20mph speed limit in Riding Dene, a permanent 20mph speed limit is proposed on Station Bank and Eastgate Bank
