### **Purpose of Report**

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of new 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) on the B6345 Riverside, Felton.

1. There is an issue with indiscriminate parking on Riverside Felton, which is causing road safety concerns.

### **Background**

#### **Introduction of 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines)**

It has been brought to the attention of Council Officers, by County Councillor Thorne and Felton Parish Council that indiscriminate parking is taking place on the B6345 Riverside Felton. This is causing road safety concerns to residents. Motorists are parking on the nearside bend opposite the war memorial causing visibility issues.

It is therefore recommended to introduce a length of 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on road safety grounds at this location. The prevention of parking at this location will increase forward visibility and promote the free flow of traffic. Civil enforcement will be carried out by Parking Services on their routine visits to the village.



Details of the proposals are shown on the plan at Appendix A.

A formal consultation did not take place, however residents were canvassed on the proposals by the County Councillor and Parish Council. Council Officers have worked closely with County Councillor Thorne and Felton Parish Council.

Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Orders.
