PROPOSED 'NO WAITING AT ANY TIME' PARKING RESTRICTIONS, CORCHESTER LANE & APPLETREE LANE, CORBRIDGE

Purpose of Report

To consider a proposal to provide 'No Waiting at Any Time' parking restrictions (double yellow lines), at two junctions in Corbridge.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the proposed No Waiting at Any Time parking restrictions are implemented.

Key Issues

Corbridge Parish Council and the local ward member have requested parking restrictions to keep the junctions of Corchester Lane with Stagshaw Road, and Appletree Lane with Aydon Road, clear of parked vehicles, in order to improve safety.

Delegated decisions

Background

1. Corbridge Parish Council and the local Ward Member identified two junctions in Corbridge where parked cars are interrupting sight lines and making it difficult for traffic to use the junctions safely.
2. The two junctions are:
 - Corchester Lane with Stagshaw Road
 - Appletree Lane with Aydon Road
3. As well as affecting sightlines for vehicles using the junctions, residents have raised issues including difficulties exiting driveways and parked cars forcing traffic into the path of oncoming vehicles.
4. Adjoining residents and statutory consultees were therefore consulted on a proposal to provide double yellow lines at the junctions to protect them from parked vehicles. The consultation plans are shown in Appendix A.
5. There was only one response from a resident in favour. No other responses were received, however, Corbridge Parish Council and the local Ward Member are in favour of the proposals.
6. It is therefore recommended that the proposed 'No Waiting at Any Time' parking restrictions are implemented.

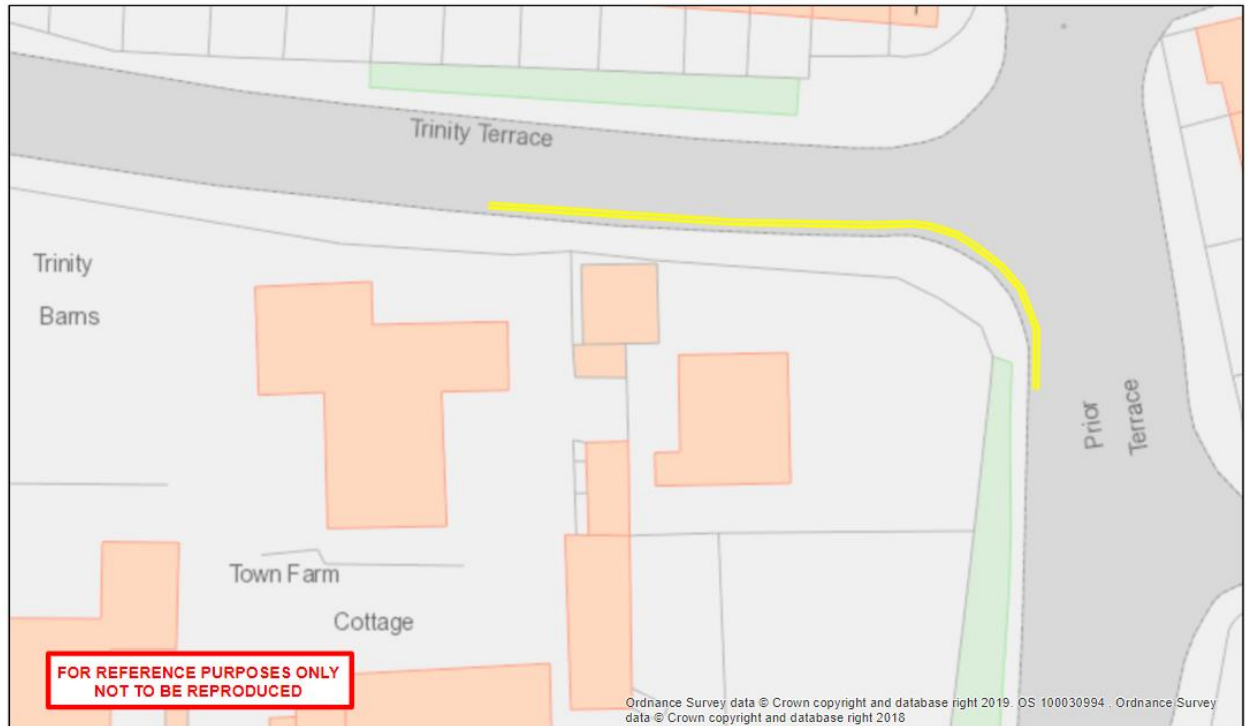

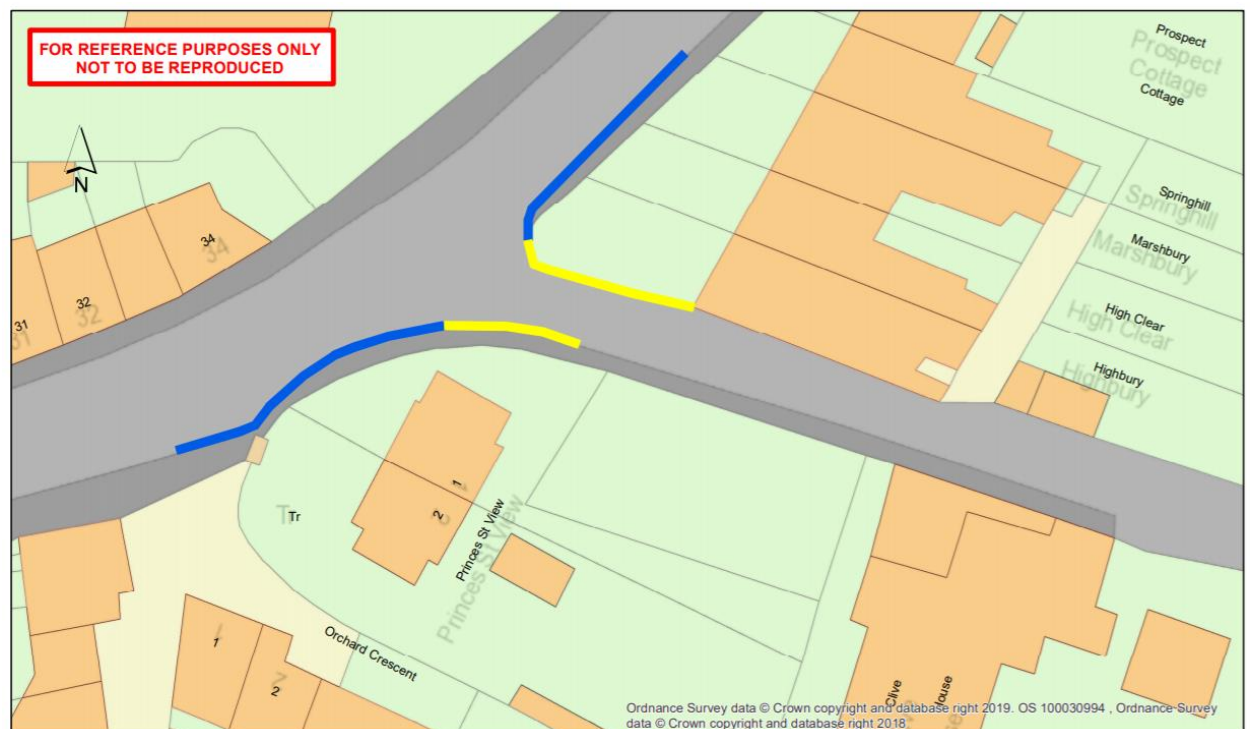
